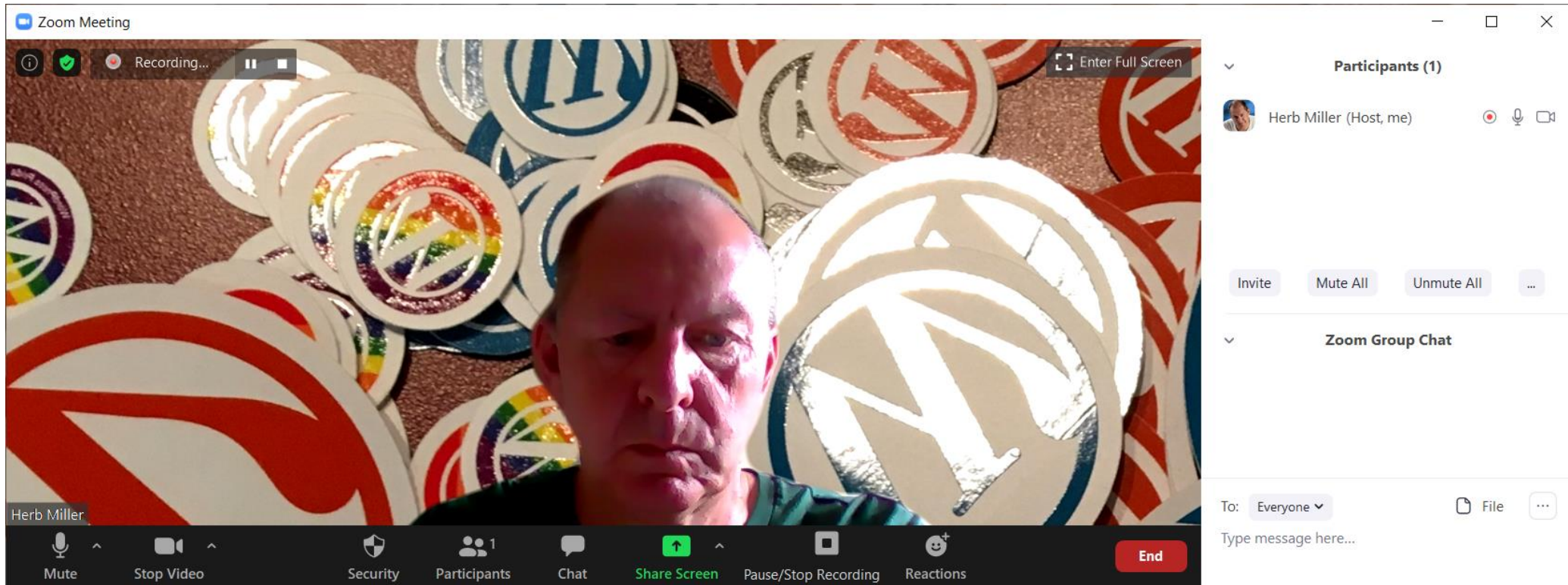

If you do not want to appear in the recording you may turn off your video. The meeting settings should *Hide non-video participants*. Also consider muting your microphone and changing your name.

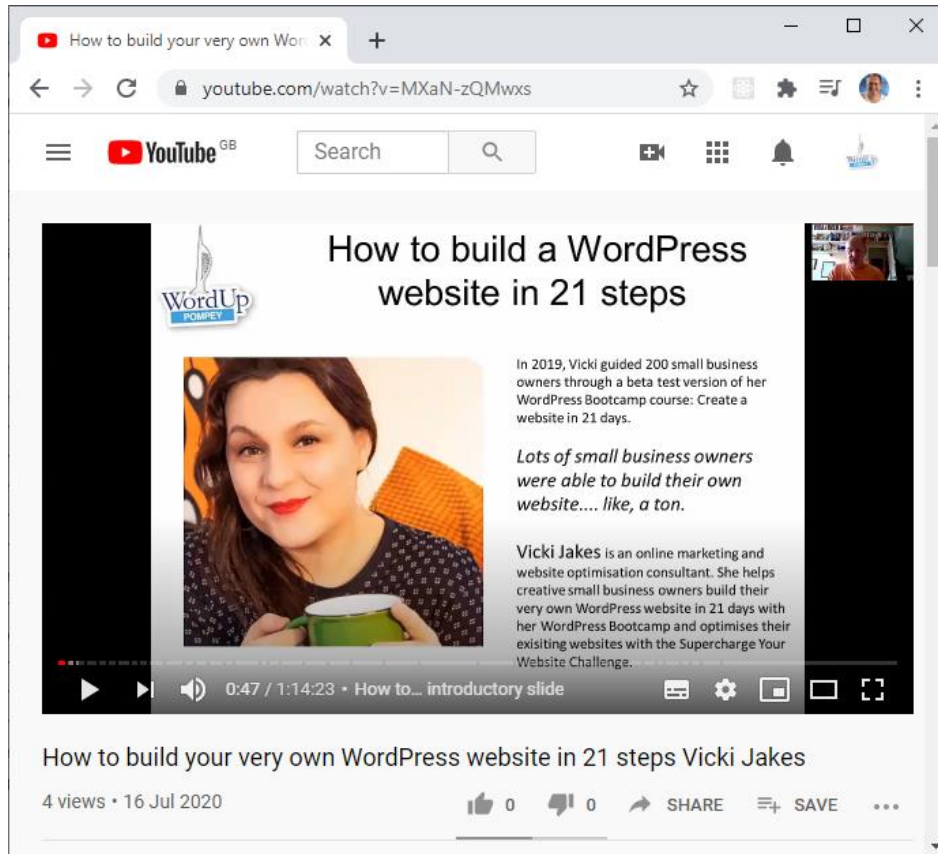
